1. Proposed Citation:

Provide a brief statement outlining the major technical accomplishment that supports the award to be used for the award.

2. Basis for the Nomination:

Submit a discourse that states presents the background on why the candidate deserves to be nominated for the award. This should include the record of technical accomplishments as an educator, researcher, administrator, or an industrial pioneer as applicable to the candidate.

3. Short Biography:

Submit a write up stating the degrees earned, with universities and dates; other post graduate studies; record of positions held; IEEE activities and offices held; OES membership and offices held; other society memberships; awards, honors, patents, inventions, and other relevant contributions.

4. Publications:

List all books, book chapters, and journal papers with the most important being highlighted stating the technical significance.

5. References:

Supply at least three and no more than five letter references from colleagues of the candidate. List the names of the references on the nomination form. All reference letters must be received by 1 May 20--
